

COVID UPDATE FOR MSMVC

As the state prepares for full re-opening we would like to provide an update to our clients regarding our COVID policies. Like many others we are cautiously optimistic that we have reached a turning point in this pandemic and that we can slowly resume more normal activities and practices.

At this time, we are still requiring that cats and dogs are brought out of the home to our mobile clinic for examinations or procedures. We will no longer require face coverings to be worn when we interact outdoors before or after examinations. If we do request that a client enter our clinic, or if we enter a home for a limited number of reasons, we will require face coverings to be worn.

We continue to ask that you please call our office to report or reschedule if you or another family member has active flu-like symptoms or if you are currently in quarantine for possible COVID exposure.
